

## Mt Washington Elementary Volunteer Process

### Ready to volunteer your time and talents during school hours? Here's how to get approved!

To volunteer during instructional hours, or if you're interacting with students on or off campus (e.g. field trips), you must be approved by LAUSD.

#### If you are a <u>new parent volunteer</u>, you'll need to turn in 3 forms to the MWE office:

- 1) Volunteer Application Form: completed, printed and signed
- 2) Volunteer Commitment Form: completed, printed and signed
- 3) Proof of negative TB Test\*: medical form provided by your doctor or clinic
- \*This test result is good for 4 years

### If you are a <u>returning parent volunteer</u>, you'll need to turn in 2 forms to the MWE office:

- 1) Volunteer Application Form: completed, printed and signed
- 2) Volunteer Commitment Form: completed, printed and signed

#### **General Guidelines**

A new application and commitment form must be completed at the start of each school year.

If your TB test results are more than 4 years old, you must submit an updated negative TB test in order to get approved.

#### Here's how you get this done:

Step #1:Click this <u>link</u> to LAUSD's Volunteer Application Process Page

Step #2: Access the online application. The link can be found under header: Volunteer Application

Process in the second bullet point. (<a href="https://volunteerapp.lausd.net">https://volunteerapp.lausd.net</a>)

Step #3: Once on the Volunteer Management System page, click on the "LAUSD parent/guardian" icon near the bottom

Step #4: Log into the Volunteer App using your Parent Portal Login info

Step #5: Download and complete the application

Step #6: Print out your completed application as well as the Volunteers Commitment Form and sign both forms

Step #7: Return both forms as well as a copy of your negative TB test to the MWE office

Step #8: Track your status on the parent portal to see when your application changes from "Pending" to "Approved"

# Once APPROVED, you may now volunteer with the students during school hours. Volunteer opportunities include, but are not limited to:

- working with students inside the classroom or on the yard, per teacher's needs and discretion
- helping on your child's gardening day
- chaperoning a field trip
- supervising Loose Parts play on either the Kinder or Main Yard
